# WHAT TO DO WHEN YOU HAVE FINISHED YOUR RIDE

Taking good care of your horse is a very big part of the equestrian sport. As we are dealing with living animals, we need to take good care that their safety and well-being comes first.

Here is a checklist of things to do after your lesson:

- 1. Dismount, run your stirrups up and secure them in place. (It's important not to leave these dangling at your pony's sides as they can get caught: Horses & ponies can catch a cheek of the bit or even a hind foot in a dangling stirrup iron when fighting flies. The dangling stirrup can also catch on doorways and other projections while you are leading the horse.
- 2. Find out if your pony is being ridden again.
- If he is, then twist the reins and secure them with the Throatlash. (Please ask your instructor to show you how to do this.) And take him to his stable. Please make sure the door is latched.
- 4. If he is not being ridden again then take the saddle off your pony and place it on one of the poles.
- Lead you pony back to his stable or paddock. If he has a martingale please don't leave the girth loop dangling. (Don't forget to give your pony a carrot!!)
- 6. Make sure the stable door or paddock gate is closed securely.
- 7. Wash your bit
- Tie your reins and martingale up in the Throatlash. (Ask your instructor to show you how)
- Hang the bridle up on it's hook in the Tack Room and please fetch your saddle
  and put it on it's correct rail in the tack room. If the rail is too high please ask for
  help.
- 10. Make sure you collect your hat, gloves and whip and don't leave anything behind.
