RIDING ATTIRE & SOME BASIC RULES

Horse riding is a very smart sport. You will see that when you watch your favourite riders on TV and social media that they are always dressed the part and are never untidy.

And so this is what we expect from our riders at Chartwell Stables. Dressing correctly not only shows a respect to our horses and our sport, but is also mostly for your own safety.

Parents: While we don't expect you to rush out and spend a fortune on horse riding gear if your child has only just started riding, it is important to think about safety while your child is mounted on top of a living being. A good HAT and pair of BOOTS is essential. Please read more below:

- Riding Hat: This is the most important piece of gear that you can possibly have so invest wisely. If you need help ask your instructor, otherwise all tack shops would be able to help you. A good hat is expensive but is the only thing protecting your child's head in a fall and there is no price on that kind of protection!
- Riding Boots: Please make sure you have HORSE riding boots (no takkies are allowed as these are very dangerous and can get stuck in the stirrup irons if you fall. School shoes with a small heel are a good alternative if you are just starting out but no boots with big heels that can get stuck.)
- Chaps: These fit over the lower leg and boot and help to keep the leg still when riding.
- Spurs: These are NOT needed at this stage of riding.
- Jodhpurs: These fit close to your skin and do not rub like jeans and tracksuit pants.
- Collared Shirt: T-shirts are fine but are not very smart. Vests are a no no as they offer no protection to your arms if you fall - you don't want roasties!! Chartwell has nice smart looking golf shirts that we would like to see you riding in.
- **Riding Whips:** Riding whips are necessary to carry whilst riding lazy ponies even if you do not use them so don't forget to get yourself one and to keep it safe!
- Hair: Should **ALWAYS** be tied up and out of the way when riding and in the yard.
- Jewellery: Should **NOT** be worn. Jewellery can get stuck or caught and can cause injury.
