NB: AFRICAN HORSE SICKNESS (AHS)

WE WILL SOON BE STARTING OUR ANNUAL AHS INNOCULATIONS



African Horse Sickness is a terrible disease which is **usually fatal** and is **extremely contagious**, so every precaution has to be taken to ensure the safety of our horses in Africa. To combat this disease we inject our horses annually. This consists of two injections, three weeks apart and is done towards the beginning of Spring when the AHS carrying midges come out and are at their worst.

These injections contain a tiny dose of the disease which is given to the horses so that their bodies can recognise it and build up an immune system to fight it.

As we are actually infecting them slightly, they need to be watched very carefully over a 6 week period to ensure that they do build up immunity and that they don't get sick. So, although lessons carry on as usual, we do take it a little easy on our steeds, especially during the second week of both the first and the second injection as hard work and exertion may drop their immune system and bring on the full blown disease.
