LIVERIES

You are more than welcome to come and ride your horses during this time but please be aware that we have half staff during the break and you will need to fetch and tack up on your own. Also, please take your tack home with you as the tack rooms will more than likely be locked.

MAKE-UPS:

Please remember that our ponies still need to be fed and cared for and our staff still need to be paid during this time and thus you will be charged for the month of December and be awarded make-up lessons for the time that we are closed.

We encourage you to book and ride these out before we close or before you go away so that we can start 2020 with a clean slate. NB: Make Ups are only held for three months. Make ups are also allowed to be used towards half the cost of pony camp ie: the camp is normally R1600 for 3 days but you may use 3 make ups and pay R800.
